- 4) Detour Routes – again – ongoing discussion. While some detour routes can be immortalized in written plans, many will be subject to the scenario at hand when confronted with the need for a detour.
- 5) Area incident discussions – we discussed the recent fatal crashed in Crawford and Bucksport.
- 6) Moving Forward:
 - a) Identification of potential stakeholders – still a work in progress.
 - b) Training needs and dates – Diane reported out on training. While we were able to very successfully move forward with training up to a few weeks ago, the spike in COVID numbers has set us back. We discussed different options and training platforms, but at the end of the day, the training block is the training block and there is not a lot of wiggle room at the present time on how to get it done. New ideas are being developed daily and there could very well be alternatives to the current training platforms soon.
