

## Bus Stop Designation Project Advisory Group

Group Purpose:	<p>To provide information on project status and to maintain a transparent process with frequent dialog and constructive communications and feedback throughout the project.</p> <p>As a member of the Advisory Group, you will act as an advocate for your constituents as well as educate your constituents and the larger community about the designation of bus stops.</p>
Group Type:	Advisory
Group Capacity:	<p>Honorary. The Advisory Group capacity is to enhance communication and public education of the designated stop project. While the Group representatives will have the opportunity to offer feedback on the project; this Group does not have any decision-making authority.</p>
Group Representation:	<p>Representatives from Community Connector staff, the partner municipalities' staff, MaineDOT staff, and members of the community representing diverse populations.</p>
Group Time Commitment:	<p>The project is expected to be completed in July 2022. An average of approximately two hours a month should be anticipated with some months requiring more, and other months requiring less time (see meeting frequency below).</p>
